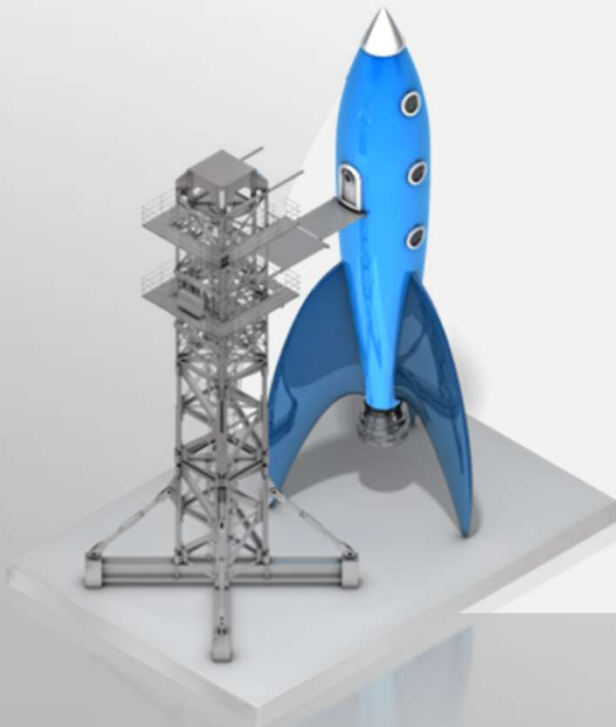

Through times of growth and change, PMI's core values provide continuity and a moral compass, communicating our beliefs and guiding our behavior.

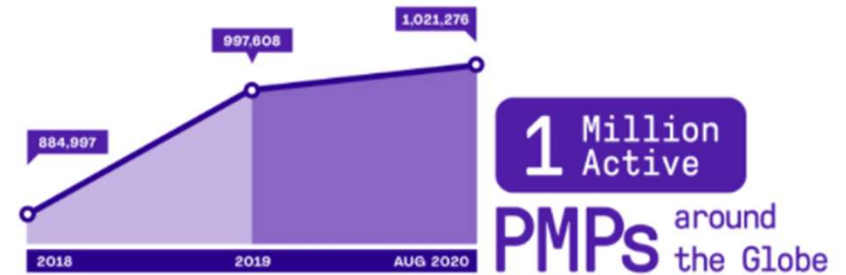
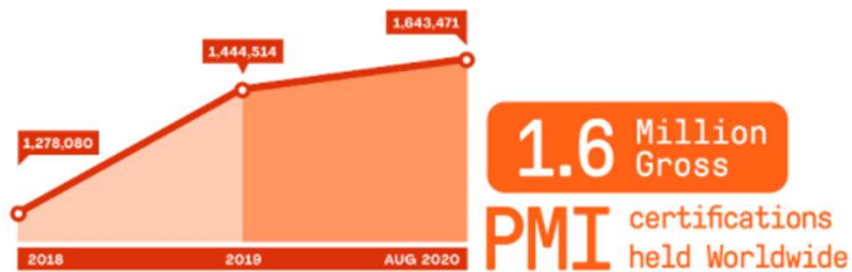
